

ACCESSIBILITY COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

pursuant to Act XVII of 2022

Hamu és Gyémánt Média Kft. (registered office: H-1024 Budapest, Margit körút 5. A building, 3rd floor, door no. 1; company registration number: 01-09-712316; tax number: 12965669-2-41; hereinafter referred to as the “Company”) hereby publishes its Accessibility Compliance Statement in accordance with Act XVII of 2022 on the general rules of compliance with accessibility requirements for products and services, and the relevant implementing regulations, regarding the website drivemagazine.ro (hereinafter: the “Website”).

1. Purpose of the Statement

The purpose of this statement is to transparently inform users of the Website about the actions the Company has taken and continues to take to meet accessibility requirements for its products and services, particularly concerning the accessibility of digital services, online interfaces, and electronic information.

2. Legal Background

The Company is subject to the provisions of Act XVII of 2022, which implements Directive (EU) 2019/882 (European Accessibility Act) into Hungarian law. The aim of the legislation is to ensure equal access to digital products and services for people with disabilities, the elderly, and other affected groups.

3. Level of Compliance

The Company declares that its digital interfaces related to its products and services – including its website, online customer service systems, electronic invoicing, and administration functions – have been developed and evaluated in accordance with the general and specific accessibility requirements defined in Annex 1 of the Act.

The compliance review covered the following areas:

- Machine readability of website content and compatibility with screen reader software
- Adjustable contrast ratios and text sizes
- Full keyboard navigation support without requiring a mouse
- Alternative access to visual and auditory content (e.g., captions, screen reading options)
- Logically structured, consistent navigation and user-friendly accessible interface
- Accessible error handling, forms, and user feedback mechanisms

The self-assessment and related development measures were based on the WCAG 2.1 (Web Content Accessibility Guidelines) AA compliance level, in line with relevant legal and professional standards. The Company is continuously working to fully comply with all accessibility requirements.

4. Feedback and Reporting Issues

The Company provides a way for users to report accessibility-related issues or submit feedback regarding the accessibility of its digital services. Accessibility-related feedback may be submitted via:

This statement is reviewed at least once every 12 months. The Company is committed to maintaining ongoing accessibility and integrates accessibility considerations during the planning and implementation of any new developments.

6. Validity of the Statement

This statement enters into force on 28 June 2025 and remains valid until the next review.
